

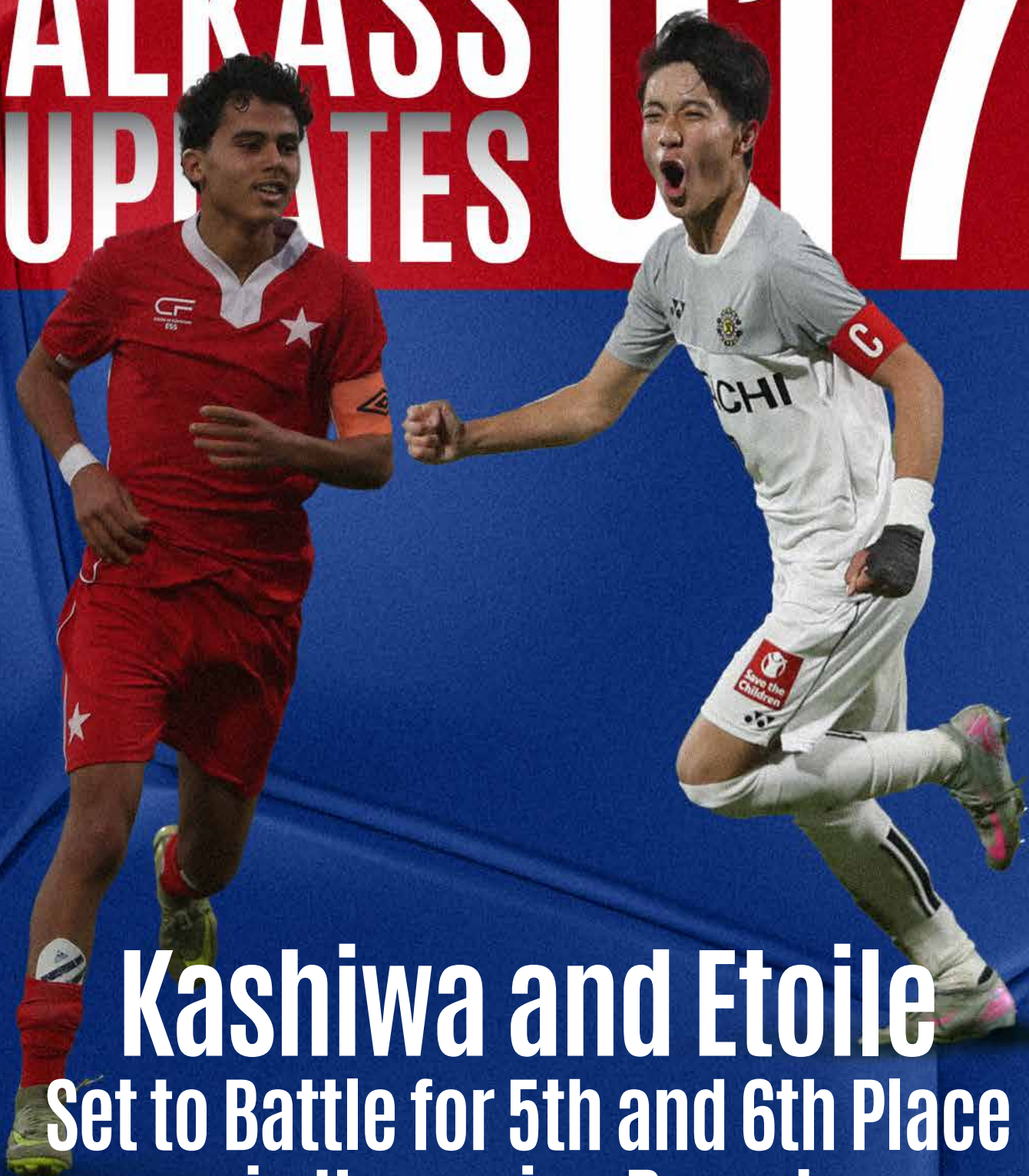

PSG AND BARCELONA

STORM INTO ALKASS SEMIS WITH COMMANDING 3-1 VICTORIES

Paris Saint-Germain secured their place in the knockout stages of the Alkass International Cup with a hard-fought 3–1 comeback victory over Kashiwa Reysol. After falling behind to an outstanding Riku Inada strike in the 19th minute, PSG leveled before halftime through Kenji Anastase's free-kick and then dominated the second half, with Nathan Mbomba and Harry! Mboma scoring in quick succession to seal the win.

In the other group match, Barcelona continued their strong form with a 3–1 win over PVF, shaking off a slow tournament start. Midfielder Robert Oliveras scored twice in the first half to build a commanding lead, and despite a goal from PVF's Hoang Truong Anh, Alex Arasa Ventaja added a late third to confirm Barcelona's victory and top spot in the group, sending them straight into the semi-finals alongside a qualifying Paris Saint-Germain.

GAME REPORT

PVF faced Étoile Sportive in challenging conditions during today's AlKass International Cup fixture, which was played under extreme dusty conditions and low visibility, which had a noticeable impact on the tempo and performance of both teams. The first half remained evenly contested between both teams. A key turning point came in the 43rd minute, when Étoile captain Al Mahdi Chikhaoui was shown a red card, reducing his side to 10 players for the remainder

of the match. Despite the numerical disadvantage, Étoile maintained their discipline and defensive shape. In the second half, Étoile capitalized on their opportunity and took the lead in the 70th minute, when Mohamed Amine Beaoui found the net to make it 1-0. PVF pushed for an equalizer, but Étoile held firm.

An additional four minutes of stoppage time were played at the end of the match, with Étoile successfully seeing out the game to secure the victory.

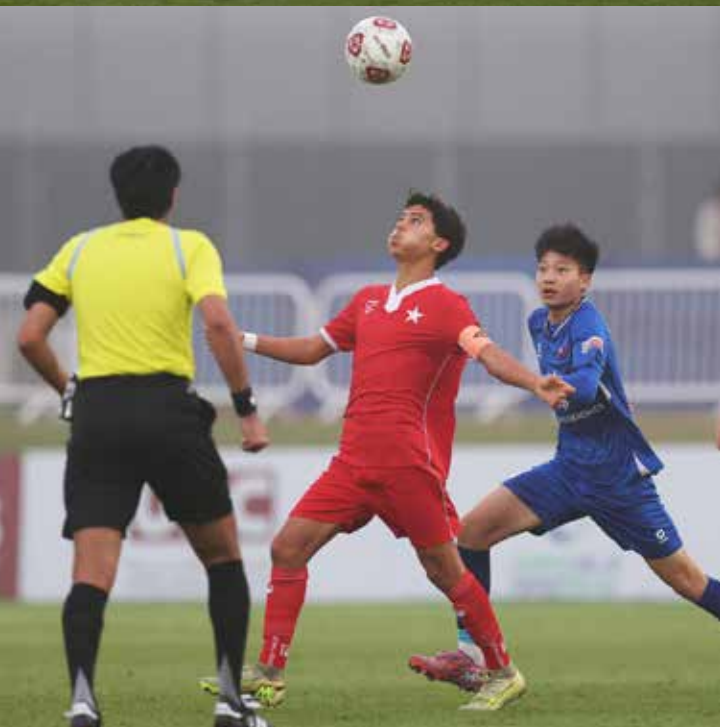

Following the match, both coaching staffs shared their views on the performance and outcome. Dinh Tmug, highlighted the physical demands on his players, explaining that the team had played two consecutive matches and was not fully recovered. He noted that the players needed time to rest and reset, admitting that his side struggled to convert chances despite creating several opportunities. He emphasized that improving attacking efficiency will be a key focus in upcoming training sessions and expressed confidence that the team can respond better in future matches.

On the other side, Mohamed Jihed Sboui praised his team's preparation and mentality, describing the match as strong and well-managed. He stated that his players successfully applied their attacking tactics and showed bold character, which helped them secure their first win of the tournament. While acknowledging that chances were limited, he highlighted the team's growing confidence and resilience, noting that this was their fourth match and that the players are gradually becoming stronger. Sboui concluded by expressing his enjoyment of the tournament and his belief in the long-term development of his players, whom he hopes to see become future stars.

GAME REPORT

Kashiwa Reysol defeated Rangers FC 2-0 in a match defined by early pressure and decisive moments. The Japanese side struck first in the 9th minute when Riku Inada converted from Toma Ishikawa's assist. Rangers responded with possession and several shots on target, but Kashiwa's goalkeeper Yujiro Yoshiguchi produced key saves to preserve the lead. The first half ended 1-0, with Rangers unable to capitalize despite creating openings.

The second half saw Kashiwa maintain composure and extend their advantage in the 71st minute through Yumeto Kikuchi. Rangers had a golden chance to reduce the deficit late on, but Yoshiguchi denied a penalty in the 84th minute. Despite their efforts, Rangers could not break through, and Kashiwa held firm to secure a deserved 2-0 victory. The win reflected Kashiwa's organization and resilience, while Rangers were left to rue missed opportunities.

The two coaches offered contrasting reflections yet agreed the tournament provided valuable lessons for their squads. Kashiwa Reysol coach Ibuki Toda expressed satisfaction with his team's performance, praising their ability to deliver a strong display despite limited recovery time between matches. He highlighted the resilience shown by his players and emphasized that while qualification for the semifinals was out of reach, the victory demonstrated their fighting spirit. Toda noted that the competition remains a valuable platform for development, stressing the importance of learning from each match and preparing with determination for upcoming challenges. Rangers FC coach Malcolm Thomson admitted disappointment at the result, acknowledging that his side struggled to recover after conceding early. He pointed to fatigue and squad changes as factors that affected rhythm, while also noting the impact of missed opportunities, including the late penalty. Thomson emphasized that the tournament offers vital experience for his young squad, explaining that defeats can be as instructive as victories in shaping their growth. He concluded by commending the organization of the competition and the opportunities it provides for developing players.
